The School Built Shed program teaches both the "hard and soft" skills of building, sales, and marketing. Youth Contractor Forum

Hosted by Southwest Washington Contractors Association (SWCA), the Young Contractors Forum is an event to educate and encourage High School students to pursue careers in the trades and will help them discover the pathways to their future careers in construction.



Grade 13 Event

The last Grade 13 event brought the top construction students from SW Washington High Schools together with the top 25 employers in Clark County. The results were 175+ interviews, all 30 students received job offers, and 26 students accepted jobs with an average starting wage of \$23/hour.
